4. 2025

- Lethbridge would like to host
 - o the university is fully willing- the AD is very enthusiastic
 - Promote it to other colleges and universities as well as within their community
 - 1 year at the U of L and maybe sharing with U of C
 - When U of C hosted only 6 teams showed up, so they want to make sure that at least 10 teams agree to come
 - By october 1st 2023 all other schools need to let Lethbridge know if they will be going
 - Go out west 1 year? Is this a possibility?
 - We don't want it to go backwards, have less teams come is not ideal
- Cost??
 - Let the girls know at the beginning of the year
 - We need to fundraise in Ontario

- 1. Lethbridge 40,000-45,000 (\$2,000 per player)
 - 1. 8,000 for the bus
 - 2. Fundraising
 - 3. \$65,000 for the year, includes coming to UCC
- 2. Calgary
- 4. Fundraising \$12,000 covers accommodations & food
- 5. Everyone pays their own flight
 - 6. 600-800 at the start and then depends on how much is fundraised for the 2nd half of the season

- 3. Dal
- 7. Dal is very good to the team (total \$25,000)
- 8. They get 12,000 to cover their cost of ice since they don't have an ice on campus
 - If we keep hosting in Ontario, could the out of province teams get some financial support?
 - o Maybe 2 nights free, maybe not paying the tournament fees?
 - \$3,000 per Ontario team instead of \$2,300
 - Lots of teams think it is a fair request (Guelph, Brock, Laurentian all nodded their heads)
- 5. Constitution is a great document, but we are not fully following it
 - We need more structure, legitimise for how everything works, or remove the constitution from the website
 - Executive committee (right now the registrar) no one is elected
 - What is the policy and procedures to make changes to the bi-laws and procedures?
 - More structure is needed
 - Our rules say we should have to have a meeting every year
 - o Online is okay too
 - Steve (Nippissing) & Chuck (Ottawa) will go through it to see what needs to be changed or updated, and bring those ideas to our next meeting. They put forward a framework and then we vote on it, clean-up the language a little
 - Dal not in agreement (were not going hap-hazard)
 - Western- we should all have a say, all the coaches
- 6. Revisit the NRL rule
 - The NRL is not what it was when we made rules like this
 - Clear this rule up with the document
 - The term now is Contract
 - A full time player that has played 7 games
 - Ottawa saying as long as they don't have a contract for sept of this year
 - Brock is in agreement
 - Guelph is saying that players who played in the previous season, but aren't playing this year should be allowed
 - Back when we created this rule, it was to make girls make the choice between NRL and university ringette
 - Make it based on the season not the calendar year
 - We will revisit this at our virtual meeting and after Chuck and Steve have looked to other changes needed to the constitution

- 7. Uwaterloo is asking to create a spreadsheet to know what each school gets from the school
 - Shella to create this and email it out and those universities that would like to add to it can
 - Create a relationship with the AD
 - Each school gets different funding from their school
 - o An athletic department is a business
 - If you try going in saying students are coming to school here to play ringette
 - Just ask- here is what were competing against
